Healthcare professionals in the following specialties would be particularly in high demand at these camps and include: General Physicians (Family Physicians), Internal Medicine specialists, Dermatologists, Pediatrics, Gynecologists, Optometrists, Ophthalmologists, Physiotherapists, Dentists and Dental Assistants, Pharmacists, Lab Technicians, Nurses, General Surgeons (able to do minor lump and bump surgeries), Psychiatrists, Dietitians. We will consider other specialties as per our need in these camps hence feel free to declare your interest even if you fall outside the above specialties.

Devotees who can't participate physically but would like to contribute towards purchase of medications (for free dispensation to patients) and purchase of medical equipment/instruments for the camps can do so by contacting Sis.
